### Office, home or school

One in five children is anxious, afraid, sad, angry or withdrawn because of emotional and behavioral disorders.

Caring professionals are a phone call away to assess, diagnose, treat and support children, adolescents and their family members.

Individual, group and family counseling, behavioral rehabilitation, physician's evaluation and medication services are available.

Parent Child Interaction Therapy is one of many techniques used by therapists. A specialist observes and coaches parents at play with their children up to age 3 years.

### Newborn to adult

Comprehensive services for children, adolescents and young adults, ages 0-24, include:

**CALM Center**, 6126 E. 32nd Place, provides intense crisis intervention and residential treatment for children and adolescents, ages 10-17.

During a three-to-five day stay, residents improve relationship and behavioral management skills. Family members also receive crisis prevention planning and education.

**Wraparound Tulsa** "wraps" community services and crisis support around at risk children with complex emotional and behavioral problems and their families.

**Positive Behavior Intervention Services** offers counseling and behavioral rehabilitation in schools to reduce suspensions, dropping out and incarcerations.

**Transition Services** helps young people, ages 17-24, as they "age out" of foster care with advocacy and support in finding education, jobs and housing for successful independence.
